Dear Parishioners,


During the last few weeks, the Gospel readings have challenged us around the following ideas: What is the kingdom of God like? Who is Jesus? And what we must do to be disciples of Christ? How we respond to these questions personally, or as a church, will determine what kind of church we have and what our relationship will be to God and the community.

It would be interesting to go around the church on a particular Sunday and hear one another's responses to those questions and then see if our practices as Christians and as a church community are consistent with those responses. As the Pastor of All Saints, I would hope that our communal response to the questions mark us out to be a welcoming community, a community committed to working for, and supporting, the quality of life for the people of our neighborhoods, a community that reaches out to those who have become marginalized, and a community that seeks to promote justice and peace, both locally, and in the greater world.

I think our parish, over the years, has done a lot of reflection on the questions at hand and it has shaped ministry in our parish profoundly. I think a good example of that has been our youth group. In the last year since they have organized themselves into a parish ministry, they have raised money to support the Children of Palomas, Mexico, and they have been involved in other projects as well. Although the youth group comes together to socialize, have fun, and pray, they also have considered how they might work together to make the lives of others better. They have not only done projects to do that, but afterwards, they reflect on their work in light of their faith. I think that it is wonderful that when they have asked for the support of parishioners, the response to them has been overwhelming. So all of us have been part of their work as well. I think that it is wonderful that the youth have inspired us all to live out in action our responses to the three questions. What is even more significant is that I can think of many other examples of how we, as a parish, have been responsive to living the life of discipleship.

As always, I want to thank all of you for your support of our parish, and in particular of our youth. We have a wonderful community. I hope and pray that All Saints will continue to be a place of welcoming, prayer, and lively ministry. Lets keep strong in Love and Faith.
