We finally broke the triple digit degree weather in El Paso, and what a difference those few degrees make! Even our poor desert plants took a beating. First with the frigid February temperatures and then with the record-breaking summer heat. We even had a hard time with the plants in the church. Everything is coming back to life, at least for a while. The beautiful plants that the Youth Group planted in our courtyard also suffered with the scorching heat. However, things are now coming back to life. The yellow marigolds have perked up and the other plants are also perking up. The Youth Group worked so diligently to make the courtyard look beautiful. I am so glad we did not lose all those plants.

I have noticed more children in attendance at the 10:30 a.m. mass. This is usually an indication that school is back in session for them. It also means that Religious Education will be starting. We started our regular CCD program on September 18th, which was Catechetical Sunday. It was a smooth start for our children. We have few children enrolled in the program but they seem to be enjoying their instruction. I want to thank the returning teachers--Letty Ramos, Mari Muñoz and Stella Ruiz and welcome the new teachers--Hector Molina and Carmen Erivez, and our teacher who is returning after a few years' absence while she finished her degree, Sylvia Trujillo. We also have two teachers who have agreed to substitute, fill in, or do "behind the scenes" type of work--Sylvia Whitson and Maria McNulty. I know this will be a great year. Our First Communion program will be starting on October 3rd. Mary Lou Romero will be teaching the children and George Keating and Pat Delgado will be teaching the parents.

Our Confirmation classes will begin on October 10th. Sarah Cancellare and Carol Muñoz will be returning with their class from last year for the second year of Confirmation. Rebekah Muñoz is their assistant. Our Confirmation I class is extremely small, our last count was three students. Alyssa Romero will team up with Gilbert Ramirez (who was confirmed in May) to teach the Confirmation I class. I think it is absolutely awesome that Sarah, Alyssa, Rebekah and Gilbert are all "graduates" of our Confirmation classes and now they are ministering to other youth.

This year, we are re-introducing our R.C.I.A. class for adults who lack one or more of their sacraments. Our parishioners expressed an interest in the class and we decided to have this class this year. The R.C.I.A. teaching team is Christina Lara, Cesar Del Rio, Sylvia Whitson, Fr. Ken and me, Paula Favela. I am excited to be part of this team because I see the need for it in our community.

In addition to these classes, we also have the Pre-Baptismal classes that take place during the year. That team is made up of Christina Lara, Mary Lou Romero, Francisca Ramirez, Sylvia Whitson, and me. Of course, Children's Liturgy of the Word is on-going with that team made up of Christina Lara, Jackie Allen, Lettie Romo, and other Confirmation "graduates" or current class members--Sammy Rago, Paulina Muñoz, Julian Muñoz, Kaitlyn Warmack and Cassie Cancellare.

I would like to thank all catechist for their dedication to our parish community. They have answered the Lord's call to serve. I appreciate all they do.
