Dear Parishioners,

As we embark on a new academic year, the various ministries at All Saints Church are busy with preparations for this year: CCD, RCIA, Youth Group and that one item that makes the world go round—the budget! The finance council at All Saints Church oversees budgetary matters for the church. This includes reviewing monies used for salaries; building insurance, maintenance and repairs; church activities (such as the mass and potluck at Memorial Park); publications (such as books for the CCD program and the mass booklets); and monthly payment of the cathedraticum (for support of the Diocese).

Another activity that the finance council is responsible for is the presentation of the budget to you—the parishioners. We do this on an annual basis and, in fact, we just recently presented the budget to you. As such, I would like to take this opportunity to stress the importance of supporting our parish through our time, talent, and treasure (the three big T's)! All of us come to All Saints because we feel a sense of belonging here; we are part of a small, but active, community. Many of us know each other and are familiar with the “regulars” at each of the masses. Moreover, most families that attend All Saints live outside the boundaries of the parish; some individuals drive over twenty miles to come to mass here. As the airlines say, “We know you have other choices” and so it is with the church we choose to attend. We all have other choices but we choose to come to All Saints. Apparently, we have found a loving home here. As such, we need to make a conscious effort to support our home. Planned giving is critical for our parish to grow and thrive. While many of us are tempted to simply open our wallets and empty the coins into the basket, or pull out a \$1.00 bill for giving, this is not planned giving. Tithing involves consciously budgeting a percentage of our income to the church and prioritizing this giving just as we prioritize paying our utility or mortgage bills. We don't want to find ourselves in the dark one day, or out of our home. Likewise, we don't want to find one day that All Saints has been closed because the parishioners did not sustain it. Our mass collections came down 6.7% last year—the equivalent of \$8,000. Our total income for the same year was down 5.0%, or \$6,674.50. The shutting down of our church may become a reality if this trend continues. Thus, I urge all of you to tithe with your heart and with your mind so that we may continue to worship and carry out God's work as a family.
